The non-refundable administration fee and seat deposit are transferable to another program or start date one time only, upon an applicant's written request and where there are international seats available. Applicants must request this transfer a minimum of 8 weeks in advance of the initial program start date. There is no guarantee that a transfer can be provided. Additional transfers are subject to an additional **\$110 application** processing fee.

Very Important Note:

After submission of online application and sending documents by Email MITT will assess the documents. If student will be eligible for the admission college will ask for \$1000 seat confirmation fees for Diploma and PG programs and \$400 seat confirmation fees for Certificate programs, which will be non-refundable in any case other than visa refusal. With one application and seat confirmation fees one defer and program change request can be possible.

NOTE:

- Students with IELTS 6.0 band overall no less than 5.5.
- Students, who have completed their 1st year study anywhere in Canada and wants to move to Manitoba for easy PR under [MINP](#) after study another year in MITT.

IELTS Requirements:**Minimum IELTS score 6.0 Bands not less than 5.5 band in each Module****Important Notes:-**

- Online Application is required.
- Ensure you use the students personal email address when applying online. An email address can only be used once to apply
- Signed consent will still be required from students.
- Original Notarized documents are required and need to send by courier.
- Once Student Accepted He / She need to pay tuition deposit for final LOA
- 12 to 14 days turnaround time for LOA
- Tuition fees must be paid before deadline mention in College offer letter. As per new SPP rule application has to pay one semester tuition fees.
- Wire Transfer details are clearly mentioned in College offer letter.
- When you are transferring funds through TT/ Wire Transfer. Please mention student's full name, Date of Birth and Student's College ID.

Application Process: -

1. Complete Online Application is required.
2. All supplementary documents can be submitted online.
3. Include Original or certified education transcripts
4. Include payment for Non-Refundable application fee and non-refundable seat deposit based on program selection.
5. Submit all documents together to MITT. (Send by courier)
6. No Conditional offer letter, need all documents with Final Degree.

SPP ADMISSION CRITERIA / GUIDELINES FOR HIGHER CHANCE OF VISA: (Recommended by CIC / Colleges)

- Fresher with good academics (Close to 60 % and above) will have good chance to get admit + Visa
- Gap in studies cannot be more than 1 years for UG and not more than 4 years for Graduates (do not submit fake experience certificate)
- Backlogs in core subjects and number of backlogs in same subject are being viewed with attention. Maximum number of 8 backlogs will be accepted. (For 12 + 4 max. 8 backlogs & for 12+3 max. 4 backlogs accepted)
- Minimum 55 % and above (higher second class) is must, However priority will be given to 60 % and above marks students
- In case of more than 8 backlogs - there should be 60 % in last 2 semester and no backlogs
- Core subject grads should be minimum 60 % and above including Math & English
 - **For Medical students**, marks in Biology, Physics & Chemistry should be close to 60 % or above.
 - **For Non-Medical students**, marks in Math, Physics & Chemistry should be close to 60 % or above.
 - **For Commerce students**, marks in Accounting, Statistics, Business & Economics should be close to 60 % or above

Important Information:

- International students admitted to any MITT certificate or diploma program (excluding post-graduate certificates), are required to take and complete the entire three-week Introduction to College and Work course prior to beginning their certificate or diploma program.
- This preparatory course provides a comprehensive framework designed to help transition international students successfully into the Canadian post-secondary and workplace environments
- Students will develop critical thinking skills, essential employability skills, and job search strategies necessary for success in the Canadian workforce.
- Attending the Introduction to College and Work course is mandatory with a strictly enforced attendance policy. Students not present on the first day, or arrive late to classes, or incur too many absences, may not be able to successfully complete their technical programs. In some cases, students may be required to retake the Intro to College and Work course (subject to available spots), and will be required to pay all associated course fees.
- Students are encouraged to plan well in advance upon arriving into Winnipeg and before the start of classes to familiarize themselves with the city and the MITT campus. Students must ensure they are present for this course, as well as the orientation week which is one-week prior.

Program Deferrals

- Available to the same program and for the next available intake only (determined by Admissions) • Available only one time per technical program application free of charge with a written notice provided 8 weeks prior to the program start.
- Students may choose to defer due to altered study plans, change in finances, life situations and/or study permit delays

How? Advise student to submit written request to admissions@mitt.ca requesting their program deferral.

Program Change

- If a student wants to be considered for a different program, they must withdraw their application from their current program and submit a new online application and pay the application fee (subject to program application availability and offering). There is no need to re-submit supporting documents as they are already on file.
- **If the request to change programs is received MORE than 8 weeks before program begins:** Student can transfer their deposit. This means that they can withdraw from the program they have been offered a seat to, we will hold their deposit in their account, and they can re-apply just like anyone else (no need to re-upload documents) and we will merge their student IDs, and IF offered a seat to the new program, their existing deposit will be applied accordingly.
- **If the request to change programs is received LESS than 8 weeks before program begins:** Student loses all non-refundable fees. They can still withdraw their application (please do so we can issue the seat to another student), and they can re-apply to any other available program, like anyone else, (no need to reupload DOCUMENTS) and we will merge their student IDs, and IF offered a seat to the new program, they will need to pay the deposit AND TUITION accordingly

Note: Use of student's personal email at the time of application When submitting an online application, it's required that the actual student's email address is being used and entered into the system. The student's email address must be from a public domain such as, gmail, Hotmail, yahoo, etc. Please be advised that the student as well as you as their agent will be cc'd in all communications.

Conditional Letters of Acceptance

- Student must have to submit Notarized Documents one month prior to the Program Start Date
- MITT will not issue the Unconditional LOA students will only receive one LOA for their enrolment at MITT, with this LOA student can put up the visa file, If students would like to receive an unconditional LOA, all final (original, or notarized copies) documents are required to be provided at the time of application.

Refund Policy for International Students (Withdrawals before the Start of Classes)

\$110.00 CAD Application fee and \$400.00 CAD / \$1000.00 CAD deposit are non-refundable. All other fees paid will be refunded. If Study Permit denied. Only \$110.00 CAD Application fee and \$100.00 CAD Administration fee will be charged and a rejection document from the Canadian Embassy or Consulate is required.

Withdrawals after the Start of Classes:

No refund will be provided unless a rejection document from the Canadian Embassy or Consulate is submitted.

Transfer Policy

International students accepted into a MITT program will be provided with **one** opportunity to transfer to an alternate MITT program at no additional charge where there are international seats available. Applicants must request this transfer a minimum of **8 weeks** in advance of their initial program application start date. e.g. If your application is for a Sept 5/13 start date, the applicant would need to provide notice on or before July 5/13 of any possible changes. No transfers will occur if the applicant provides less than 8 weeks' notice. There is no guarantee that a transfer can be provided.

Note: In case of Visa refusal and/or withdrawal, student must have to bear difference amount while getting refund money from college due to dollar rate fluctuation. It will be less approximately Rs. 50,000 /- to 60,000.

Airport Pickup Service:

- Airport Pickup service is available for the international student at the charge of \$100,
- Student need to send Airport Pickup services form with the Air Ticket to confirm the Airport Pickup service prior to 1 week of Travel Date.
